About Funding

Through a competitive peer review process, SHRF and partners support direct costs for research projects taking place in Saskatchewan with measurable impact in focused areas through two opportunities:

Innovation Grant

Catalyzing the development of innovative solutions to address pressing health challenges.

Impact Grant

Advancing the translation of evidence based solutions into real-world and practical applications.

Up to \$50,000 over one year

Up to \$150,000 over two years
